

Child development center accredited

NORTHBORO -- The Boroughs Family Branch YMCA's Center for Child Development, in the Trinity Church at 23 Main St., has earned accreditation from the National Association for the Education of Young Children, the nation's leading organization of early childhood professionals.

The Center for Child Development in Northboro is one of three centers run by the Boroughs Family Branch YMCA, part of the YMCA of Central Massachusetts. To earn NAEYC accreditation in the new system, the center went through an extensive self-study process, and was measured against 10 new NAEYC Early Childhood Program Standards, as well as more than 400 other criteria.

The Northboro center offers a full-day program for children 2.9 to 7 years of age. This site includes preschool, nursery school, and kindergarten.
